

The Study

The study, also referred to as the living room, is highlighted by wooden glass-doored bookshelves which flank both sides of the fireplace. (The fireplace is embellished with a carved wooden lion's head and leaves.)

A modern striped wallpaper is present on the walls, and we recommend that it be removed and be replaced with a more appropriate turn-of-the-century patterned paper. This wallcovering would be enhanced by a border paper along the ceiling moldings.

Despite the two large front windows and the two casement windows above the bookshelves and flanking the chimney, the room is fairly dark. To help correct this problem, a gas/electric chandelier is suggested. (Such a fixture had once been in the room but was removed in recent years.) A floor lamp and one or two table desk lamps are also suggested.

As stated earlier, the large front windows should be dressed with lace curtains and heavy, lined side drapes. Shades should also be installed. The two casement windows should be left unadorned.

The floor was covered with a room-size domestic red rug. It is recommended that this treatment be duplicated.



The Dining Room

Like the parlor, this is an elaborately detailed room. It is wainscoted with paneled mahogany and features an exquisite mahogany-pillared, mirrored mantle. The mantle is further beautified by a leaded glass cupboard for dishes. The glass mullions form a delicate fleur-de-lis pattern.

The current wallpaper above the wainscoting is a somewhat geometric gold design on an off-white background. This paper was installed in 1961 and is thus deemed inappropriate. Another wall covering is needed, but because there might be frequent business transactions between the occupants of this room and the study it has been decided that the same wallpaper and border pattern used in the study be hung in the dining room. The large floral pattern is historically sound and the color, a yellow/gray, is dark enough to satisfy the often darkly decorated dining room themes of this restoration period.

The presence of a three-windowed bay gives the room most of its natural light. Like the parlor and study, the windows should have lace curtains and rather richly embossed, heavy, lined drapes. To increase illumination, however, it is recommended that the present 1930-40 chandelier be replaced with a gas/electric reproduction chandelier. Various floor and table/desk lamps are also suggested.

A red, room-sized domestic rug once covered the floor and it is suggested that the same type of rug be purchased.





The Bathroom

By 1900 bathrooms were common in homes such as this one. Cleanliness was a top priority, and this clean, just-scrubbed look found a new expression in bathroom interiors. Although most bathrooms were small, this did not necessarily mean a scaled-down decorating scheme. Bathrooms were sometimes as elaborate as other rooms in the house.

In view of this, the following recommendations for the Rogers House first floor bathroom are made. The all-white fixtures and tile dado give the room brightness and in keeping with this light-airy feeling; a Japanese motif wallpaper, in a white on white color scheme, is recommended. However, in view of budgetary concerns, it is suggested that the walls be scraped and repainted white until the paper may be purchased.

The ceiling should be painted white as well as the exposed pipes.

Faucet fixtures should be polished and lacquered and the same treatment should be given to the ceiling light.

The large bathroom window can be treated with a window shade and white lace sheers.

The present towel rack and tissue holder should eventually be replaced with white porcelain ones.

The make-shift wooden shelf on the southern wall should be removed.

The ceiling fixture should be replaced with a more appropriate turn-of-the-century one.

The newly painted tan walls should be seen as a very temporary treatment.



The Hallway

The most salient feature of the hallway is the presence of the Lincrusta-Walton dado. This embossed wallcovering was very popular in the late nineteenth century, and it is fortunate that most of it is still in excellent condition. It is unfortunate, though, that one wall, the victim of water damage, had much of its Lincrusta-Walton ruined and/or lost. This damage was caused by water seeping through this brick/plaster lathe wall from the adjacent back porch gutters. This wall was mortised in 1905 in order to create a notch where the back porch eaves could rest. This problem has been corrected and the interior wall has been replastered.

However, the problem of repairing the Lincrusta-Walton dado still persists. This task has now been further complicated by the removal of all the Lincrusta-Walton in the damaged wall area. This occurred when the wall was replastered. A quick solution to this problem has been the painting of the wall surface a dark

brown to match the color of the Lincrusta-Walton.

While it would be ideal to replace the damaged wallcovering, it is rather impossible to do so because it is no longer manufactured in the United States. Taking a photograph of the wallcovering and then enlarging it so it might be hung on the wall is another option, but it too is impossible because of cost. One final solution might be the reproduction of the wallcovering through the use of paper mache. Instructions for doing this are found on Appendix F. . . This work should not be done by an amateur.

The area above the dado is covered in a post-World War II scenic wallpaper. Due to its late date, this wallpaper is being removed and replaced with a vinyl, burlap simulated paper. (As mentioned earlier, to cover the wall in burlap would have been much too expensive.) The color of the new wallpaper is off white to blend

with other papers used on the first floor and to lighten up the hallway.

The hallway is presently illuminated by two hanging fixtures. The front hall fixture is not original and post dates the early 1900 period. A recommendation for its replacement is given in succeeding pages. The back hall fixture will remain as is. Since the official reception area will be located in the back hall area, additional indirect lighting is needed. A floor lamp and desk lamp are suggested.

There is only one window in the hallway, but there are two glass-paned doors. These three light sources will all need treatment. We recommend that the window have sheer curtains and heavy drapes. Both the front and back doors can be covered

with sheer door panel curtains.

There were numerous floor rugs in the hallway. A domestic rug covered the floor from the staircase to the front door and several other small oriental rugs were found in the middle and back areas of the hall. To duplicate these coverings would not only be costly but also impractical. We suggest that an oriental-inspired commercial carpet be used throughout the hallway and on the stairs. This carpeting also meets flame retardant requirements.

One last comment on the hallway interior is the removal of the two outdated gas radiators and the restoration of the damaged Lincrusta-Walton paper immediately behind these.







Interior Evaluation

Second Floor

Bedroom #1 (top of stairs to the left)

Plaster and paint are peeling and falling off the ceiling near the bay window projection.

The windows have metal drapery rods. The middle window needs to have its lock repaired. All other locks and brass window pulls are present.

The mirrored mantle with its beaded frame is in good shape.

The condition of the floor cannot be determined at this point due to furniture in the room.

Bedroom #2 (Front West end)

The big concern in this room is the fireplace mantle. It is very loose and is being held in position by two hinge brackets. There are also water stains on the right side of the fireplace and above the door connecting this room to bedroom #1.

The ceiling needs to be scraped, plastered and repainted.

There are no drapery rods, but the window pulls and locks are present.

Bedroom #3

This room is in good condition overall. The three windows have all of their necessary hardware, as well as wood drapery rods and rings.

The fireplace mantle is unmarred, and the floor is in good condition. There is a gash in the wood on the closet door.

The ceiling is cracked and needs to be repaired, and there is a hole in the ceiling in the northwest corner of the room.

The light fixture which hangs to the right of the fireplace needs a new shade.

Hallway

It looks like there has been water damage under the hallway window.

The wallpaper is coming loose in several places.

The window has a wood drapery rod and rings. The brass sash pulls and window lock are intact.

The ceiling paper is splitting in places.

The front hall gas/electric fixture was made by GECO, which might stand for General Electric Company. It is in need of a glass shade. The back hall light is also a gas/electric fixture made by GECO. It too needs a shade.

The bannister and railing are in good condition, as is the fireplace mantle and corner beads.

Bedroom #1

The first room on the left as one ascends the stairs is the largest bedroom, situated over the dining room and possessing a projected bay window area. this room is referred to as bedroom #1.

This room will be papered with a small feather design wall covering. feathers are blue on a tan background. A wide chrysanthemum design border will accent the upper wall area.

The bay windows will boast sheer curtains and heavy side drapes.

Artificial light is provided with a bare-bulbed ceiling fixture. We suggest that a dome cover be purchased for aesthetic reasons. Several table/desk lamps will be needed to provide adequate lighting, and suggested lamp styles are included on page

A room size rug should be purchased for the floor.

Interior details in this room include a fairly massive wood fireplace mantle highlighted by a mirror and ionic columns. Although the room has no wainscoting, there are rather handsome corner beads on the bay window corners. There is also a built-in wall closet.

The most immediate problem in this room is the deteriorated condition of the ceiling plaster in the bay area. The source of this condition has been corrected, but the problem of efflourescence still exists.

This room will be papered with a pale beige, small patterned wallcovering and the same border pattern as bedroom #1. Here again, the occupants of both rooms will frequent each other's offices, and therefore harmonizing interiors is recommended.

The three large windows should have sheer lace curtains and heavy, lined side drapes.

The ceiling light should have a dome cover and the floor a room-size rug.

The interior detail in this bedroom is concentrated mainly on the fireplace which has a mirror and carved wood columns and floral motif. A built-in closet is also present.


Leave the present ceiling fixture as is but install a dimmer switch to adjust light.

If the tenants desire to keep the hanging fixture located to the right of the fireplace, a new shade may be purchased from Renovator's Supply, Inc.

The Hallway

Unlike the first floor hallway, the upper hall never had wainscoting. Nor was it painted. Rather, it was papered and had a modest border paper trim. A fairly small patterned wallpaper (that is specifically manufactured to complement that which is in bedroom #2) and a floral border is recommended. Those choices give the hall some detail and help to lighten it up as there is only one window in the hall.

The hall is lit by two hanging ceiling fixtures. The fixture at the top of the stairs is a gas/electric one and should remain intact. We suggest that a glass shade be purchased for the bare bulb. The fixture at the south end of the hall has a single bare bulb. Recommendations for its replacement are given in the next few pages.

Floor coverings presently consist of several small rugs and runner pieces. In order to reduce noise and maintain period accuracy, rugs of similar color and patterns as those which are there are recommended. (Upon occupancy, these rugs will be removed by the donor.) Suggestions follow.

The hall window can be dressed in simple sheers.

At the northern end of the hallway is a small-scaled, but well detailed fireplace. The fireplace has ionic wood columns and a carved floral motif. A mirror, framed in wood, spans the mantle.


V. Lighting
